- Actively participates in daily calling activities; tracks and records calls and results; performs joint calls with Branch Manager and Business Partners; refers opportunities to specialty lines of business
- Provides call lists and coaches staff on tele-consulting sales calls, tracks calls and results
- Coordinates outside business development calls with manager.
- Identifies and builds relationships with COI (Center of Influence) contacts
- Identifies and shares 'best practices'.
- Conduct At Work Presentations for businesses to bank their employees
- Works with ROM or AROM to resolve account issues, as needed.
- Perform Sales Management duties as assigned
- Opens/Closes personal and commercial accounts, IRA's, CD's and other account types.
- Performs activities/provide leadership to assist the branch in meeting expectations around key focus areas
- Coordinates daily with Manager on any updates on branch staff and daily activities of branch
