Re: Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998

Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998

Dear Participant or Beneficiary:

The Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1998 requires us to inform you that following a mastectomy, the services listed below are covered by the Plan in a manner determined in conjunction with the attending physician and the patient. The provisions of this law became effective for medical care received on or after January 1, 1999.

- Reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed.
- Surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance.
- Prosthesis and treatment of any physical complications resulting from mastectomy, including lymphedemas.

The coverage provided under this law will be subject to the same co-payments, deductibles, and other provisions that apply to mastectomies under the terms of the Plan as described in your Summary Plan Description booklet.
