These statements must be attested before a notary public or officer of court, and the seal of said officer must be affixed, also witnessed by two directors.

On Form 2 should be made a copy which is for the use of the printer publishing the report as required by law. Please see if the attestation of the publisher is properly made out before sending the form to this office.

FROM BANKING ACT OF 1907. SECTION 10, PAGES 87 AND 88.

SEC. 10. Every bank, trust company shall make at least four reports each year, and oftener if called upon by the State Bank Examiner, according to the form which may be prescribed by him, verified by the oaths or affirmation of the president or cashier of such association and attested by the signature of at least two of the directors. Each such report shall exhibit in detail and appropriate heads the resources and liabilities of the bank, trust company or association at the close of business on any *past date* by him specified and shall be transmitted to the State Bank Examiner within ten days after receipt of a request
